Praise God for a big *Impact!* **Impact 2012**, the Alliance youth winter retreat held here at PPC every January, was the best-attended retreat in years. Nearly 80 teens and youth leaders converged on camp on Friday the 13<sup>th</sup>, and had a blast through Monday afternoon.

The theme was "Called to Duty" this year. Larry Williams, pastor at Crossroads Fellowship in Clarksville, TN, challenged the teens with messages about how the Lord calls us to salvation, to being empowered by the Holy Spirit, to obedience, to being His witnesses, and to growing in the Lord. Several counselors presented seminars discussing different

topics related to our walk with the Lord. Many of the games played over the weekend had "Call of Duty" themes, such as "Battle Plan" and "Seek and Find." There was even a super-messy mud war at the pond!

During the course of the weekend, at least 3 teens made professions of faith, and many more grew closer to the Lord and their commitment to Him. Pastor Larry says that, "We know for a fact many conversations are still going on as people calculate the costs of discipleship. Continue praying for those wrestling these tough issues."

It's a hard world to grow up in these days, so please pray fervently for the youth that come to Poplar Point Camp, that Christ would be at work in their hearts while they are here and that His work would continue when they return to their homes and schools.
